Bottle

- 1. Pierre Javert Dry White Vin de Pays de Cotes de Gascogne, France** **£13.25**
A clean fresh dry white with irresistible floral style **(House Dry)**
- 2. Vicuña Semillon/Sauvignon, Central Valley, Chile** **£13.95**
A deliciously crisp, classic combination from the sunny Central Valley of Chile, wedged between the mountains and the sea. An aromatic and flavour-filled white for easy drinking. **(House Medium)**
- 3. Pleno Viura, Navarra, Spain** **£13.95**
Fresh and crisp white with hints of tropical fruit, smooth and well balanced. Very well made wine from a go-ahead bodega.
- 4. Rudesheimer Rosengarten Silvaner, Moselland, Germany** **£13.95**
This has lovely forward fruit with flavours of pears and green apple. Fresh, lively acidity and medium sweetness on the palate make it especially refreshing drinking.
- 5. Trivento Viognier, Argentina** **£16.95**
Enticing fruit flavours jump out of the glass in this delightfully fragrant Viognier from Argentina.
- 6. Amanti del Vino, Pinot Grigio, Delle Venezie, Italy** **£18.95**
Pinot Grigio from northern Italy is the dry white wine of the moment! This one, from near Venice, is crisp, refreshing and unoaked, making it perfect for drinking before or during any meal.
- 7. C J Pask Sauvignon Blanc, Hawke's Bay, New Zealand** **£19.95**
A typical New Zealand Sauvignon with opulent, ripe, tropical fruit and all the classic Sauvignon character one could wish for. This is from a winery on the outskirts of Hastings run by dynamic duo, Chris Pask and Kate Radburnd.
- 8. Chablis, Domaine des Valery, France** **£24.95**
This is textbook Chablis from one of the area's most successful producers. It has green-tinged hues, an elegant slightly steely quality with aromas and flavours of freshly baked brioche.
- 9. Pouilly-Fuissé, Cuvée vieilles vignes en Ffts de Chêne, N et M Guerrin, France** **£34.95**
Grapes from low yielding, 45 year-old vines make a beautifully intense yet elegant Pouilly-Fuissé, the top wine from grower Maurice Guerrin. He ferments it in barrel, working the lees to give roundness and a yeasty, dry finish.

Soft and full, with juicy red and black fruits in this classic combination of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. A very easy style. | £13.95

Soft, fruity red from blend of the Merlot and Syrah grape varieties | £13.95 |
| 12. Pleno Tempranillo, Navarra, Spain
A full, meaty wine with lots of spicy plum fruit and soft tannins providing the structure. Nice weight and good length. | £13.95 |
| 13. Ladera Verde Merlot, Central Valley, Chile
This has lovely plummy Merlot fruit with a ripeness that is so typical of Chile. Easy and very drinkable. | £14.95 |
| 14. Zarapito Malbec Bonarda, San Juan, Argentina
The rich fruit of the Malbec combines perfectly with the spice of the Bonarda. | £15.95 |
| 15. Lyrebird Shiraz/Cabernet, Victoria, Australia
From the family run Wingara Winery in Mildura comes this ripe and fruity red that overflows with berries, plums and a dollop of vanilla oak. Well- balanced, soft and juicy. | £17.95 |
| 16. Tanners Claret, Bordeaux, France
This has been made even more attractive by the addition of some extra old-vine Merlot to give it a bit more of the succulence and juiciness for which it is renowned, while still retaining its classic balance and style. | £18.95 |
| 17. Fleurie, Domaine de la Virolette, J Charlet, France
Attractive, wild strawberry fruit is abundant in this wine making it a particularly juicy example. Fleurie is the most famous of the ten superior, 'cru' villages of Beaujolais. | £25.95 |
| 18. Viña Real Reserva, Rioja, CVNE, Spain
The winemaking here is ably controlled by Jesus Madrazo who shows a skilled touch, especially with this Reserva. The flavours are of ripe strawberry overlaid with typical vanilla oak from the 4 years in barrel. Floral and mature. | £34.95 |

| This is an off-dry, fruity rosé, with plenty of strawberry flavours and lively, refreshing acidity. A good partner for many foods including those with a little spice. | (House Rose) |
| 20. Angel's Flight White Zinfandel, California, USA | £16.95 |
| A juicy refreshing rosé packed full of crushed strawberry and raspberry fruit. The finish is well balanced with a hint of sweetness. | |
| 21. Pinot Grigio Rosé, Provincia di Pavia, Ca' Solare, Italy | £18.95 |
| A copper pink rosé from Northern Italy's Pavia region with gently fragrant summer fruits on the nose and delicate strawberry fruit on the palate. Fruitily off-dry. | |

| A good characterful Champagne with fine mousse, full fruity flavour and a toasty finish. | |
| 24. The Thornescroft House Rosé Champagne, France | £35.95 |
| A gorgeous, rich rosé colour with typical Pinot fruit on the nose, wonderfully fresh with notes of red-berried fruit and cherries. The mousse is fine with lovely richness and well-balanced acidity. An excellent, full-flavoured rosé. | |
| 25. Veuve Clicquot Brut Yellow Label | £49.95 |
| The full flavour of this champagne comes from good maturation. Soft, baked bread and biscuity nose, with creamy white fruits and a long lasting flavour. Stylish, elegant and full-bodied. | |
